Subject:- **Illegal detention, physical abuse and torture of 13 year old child, named Sonu @ Bhole S/o Sh. Ved Pal resident of Krishna Colony under Sector-4 police station, by Haryana police at Gurgaon .**

Ref:- **NCPCR New Delhi File No. HR-11015/22548/2010-11/S.M. Comp dated 02-08-2011.**

As you are aware the above captioned infamous case was reported by press and it brought to the fore a larger malaise. The National Commission for Protection of Child Rights (NCPCR) took the suo-moto cognizance of Hindustan Times News report date 02-04-2011 under section 13 (1) (i) of the CPCRA Act-2005. A thorough inquiry conducted by the NCPCR established that the child was illegally detained and tortured by the Police, in custody.

Hence the NCPCR vide its letter under reference, in Para 5 (vi) has directed that a monetary compensation to the extent of Rs. 25000/- for the physical torture and mental trauma caused upon due to inhumane treatment at the hands of police, be paid immediately to the child Sonu.

You are, therefore, requested to please arrange payment of compensation of Rs 25000/- to the victim, Sonu, as per directions of the NCPCR New Delhi at the earliest, so that the compliance report be sent.
