

NATIONAL COMMISSION FOR PROTECTION OF CHILD RIGHTS

Position: Senior Consultant (Child Labour)

(1) Nature of Work:

- i. To deal with all issues matters/files relating to Child Labour in the NCPCR;
- ii. To look after all the works of the Expert/Working Group that may be constituted by NCPCR on the issues relating to Child Labour and related matters;
- iii. To handle all the correspondence, meetings and their minuting on the issue;
- iv. To compile the data and prepare reports on the issue of child labour that may be required for filing in the Supreme Court/High Courts and/or for policy documents of NCPCR;
- v. Any other work that may be assigned from time to time.

(2) Qualifications/Experience:

- i. A postgraduate degree from a recognized University in social work/ psychology/ child development/ sociology/ law/ Political science
- ii. 08 years of working experience in project formulation/ implementation/ monitoring and/or scrutinizing/ analyzing/writing reports on social sector/development sector issues.
- iii. Experience of dealing with the issues and laws relating to child labour would be an added advantage.
- iv. Proficient in working on Computer and excellent communication skill (oral and written) in English and Hindi.
- v. Knowledge of some of the regional languages would be an added advantage.

(3) Competencies:

- i. Should have clarity in thought and highly motivated.
- ii. Should be willing/able to travel out as and when necessary.
- iii. Should be able to work within deadlines.

(4) Period of Assignment and Remuneration etc.

- i. The engagement will initially be for a period of 06 months, extendable to a maximum period of 01 year, based upon necessity and performance.
