NCPCR joins hand with Indigo Airlines to create awareness on Child Sexual Abuse.

National Commission for Protection of Child Rights (NCPCR) and Indigo Airlines together today launched an awareness campaign on protection of children from sexual abuse and promotion of NCPCR's POCSO e-box, an online complaint mechanism about sexual abuse of children.

As a part of this campaign information, messages about Child Sexual Abuse will also be printed by airlines in their e-ticket itinerary and bus grab handle in Tarmac coaches. Message from WCD Minister, Smt. Maneka Sanjay Gandhi will be displayed on the video panels of Tarmac coaches. The same message will be published in their Flight Magazine, Hello 6 E.

It is expected that awareness messages will reach thousands of airlines passengers including children. POCSO e- box is an online drop box where anyone including child victim of sexual abuse can report such offences. The e-box is available at NCPCR's home page www.ncpcr.gov.in.
