

**NATIONAL COMMISSION FOR PROTECTION OF CHILD RIGHTS RESCUES
TRAFFICKED 7 MINOR GIRLS FROM SARAN DISTRICT OF BIHAR**



National Commission for Protection of Child Rights (NCPCR), directed the Superintendent of Police, Saran to undertake immediate action in connection with trafficking of minor girls in Saran District, Bihar.

Maintaining strict confidentiality, rescue teams conducted a pre-dawn raid at approximately 4:00 AM on 25.06.2026 and successfully rescued seven minor girls who had allegedly been trafficked for exploitation in orchestra performances. The rescued children are being placed under the care and protection of the concerned Child Welfare Committees (CWCs) for rehabilitation and restoration.
